Upon passing testing, I would assemble the **PHP** WordPress components along with documentation. Later, I would conduct training for clients. Other functions included testing, peer code review and migrating content into WordPress from other CMSs.

Placewise designs and maintains websites and many other marketing materials for brick-and-mortar malls. My job was to write the code designs into reusable templates.
